

FACT ABOUT JAMMU AND KASHMIR

1. Article 370 gave special autonomous status to Jammu and Kashmir.
 2. It allowed the state to have its own constitution and flag.
 3. The state had autonomy over internal administration.
 4. India controlled defence, foreign affairs, and communications.
 5. It was added in 1949 as a temporary provision in the Constitution.
 6. Article 35A allowed the state to define "permanent residents."
 7. It restricted property rights and some government jobs to locals.
 8. On August 5, 2019, the Government of India revoked Article 370.
 9. The state was reorganized into two Union Territories: Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh.
 10. In December 2023, the Supreme Court of India upheld the revocation as constitutional.
- In Short : In 2023, the Supreme Court approved (upheld) the removal of Article 370 and confirmed that the 2019 decision by the Government of India was legal and constitutional.

Torch Flame: The Current flame is Covered in 24k gold leaf

When it was unveiled in 1886, it was shiny brown Colour. By 1906, the Colour had Changed to green. Now, the statue of liberty is green because its Copper surface reacts with air (oxidation) to form a Patina (Shallow layer deposited layer on a Surface). Because the patina Protects the Copper from damage.






GREEN UTSAV CELEBRATION

NEVER GIVE UP


Life is full of difficulties. Everyone faces failures at some point in life, but success belongs to those who never give up. Giving up stops progress, while persistence leads to achievement.

Do not put your child down in front of other people.


Children must be taught to take a 'no' from parents as well as friends, teachers etc.
